- Thank you parents for being vigilant with screening your child daily for covid-19 symptoms
- Thank you parent council for the Christmas cookies & oranges
- Covid-19 outbreak was declared at Madonna on December 21, 2020. In the Grade 1 class, 3 cases were asymptomatic but 1 case showed symptoms. 3 families showed symptoms over Christmas break
- Alberta education has not yet released their annual survey. Traditionally this has gone to grades 4, 7 & 12
- EICS has emailed parents their survey on January 25, 2021. If you have children in multiple schools, please complete a survey for each school.
- Report cards are available online January 29, 2021
- \$500.90 raised by "Bend the rules" event at school today, in support of Chalice Child
- There is a large range in literacy levels in each class. All of Alberta is experiencing this due to being out of school for so long in 2020. All Madonna classes are doing guided reading & working with students in small groups on specific skills
- There was one complaint regarding quality of online learning during the 3 days after Christmas
 - January 29, the staff have a full morning with a teacher who is online fulltime through Edmonton Regional Learning Consortium.
 - All teachers in the building have different skill sets, but we have a standard to attain. We are developing to get there.
- Valentine's Day: February 12, 2021 activities. There will be no food & no card exchanges between students. Each class will instead be making cards to send out to community groups. For example, Horizon Village and the army
 - Sue-Ann D has volunteered to research virtual card exchange options for students to send to eachother
- Shrove Tuesday: February 16, 2021 there will be no food served at the school. Karen A would like to include into the S'more a write up of what Shrove Tuesday means as well as a recipe for pancakes and a prayer

- Erin C suggested that families could send their children with pancakes for lunch. All in attendance agreed this is a great idea
