

## Field Trip Fees and How I Pay Them?



### Fees:

Kindergarten students participate in a number of field trips out of school. Field trip fees will be charged on a per activity basis during the year. Information will be sent home at that time and any fee due will be payable online under your Parent Portal account.

### Parent Portal:

This is an account that you will create for yourself in our schools software system called PowerSchool. At your Orientation Session you will be given your log-in information to create an account. Your account will give you access to your child's school fees, online report cards, student forms and more! You can pay your fees using debit or credit card online.

# General Kindergarten Information

2017-2018 School Year

Children need to be 5 years old on or before December 31, 2017 to be eligible for the 17/18 Kindergarten class.

1. Complete the registration form on-line at <https://mcs.eics.ab.ca/> and be sure to include a copy of your child's Birth Certificate. Student busing may also be requested on-line at [www.eics.ab.ca](http://www.eics.ab.ca) under menu option "Transportation".
2. Attend the Open House on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017 from 7:00 to 8:00 with your Kindergarten student.
3. Sign-up for an Orientation Session on-line at [www.schoolinterviews.ca](http://www.schoolinterviews.ca) using Event Code: 5duqk
4. Participate in the First Ride Program with your child if they will take the bus next year.

## Orientation Sessions

To start off on the right foot, we introduce our Kindergarteners to school in small groups, offering them an opportunity to view their school and classroom prior to the first day.

- Students receive special, personal one-on-one time with their teacher to help them feel comfortable.
- Students will be shown where to put their belongings such as coat/shoes/backpacks.
- A tour of their class, washrooms, library, gym and office will take place.
- A photo of each student will be taken for their name tag.
- Students will be invited to participate in a few activities.

In general, this session will help your child feel less apprehensive on their first day of Kindergarten.

## School Supplies



Though supplies will be provided by the Madonna Catholic School Kindergarten teacher, there are two personal items you will need to supply for your child.
