Our new social studies unit focuses on the community of Iqaluit, Nunavut. Keeping with this theme on Friday, March 1st both grade two classes will be attending a presentation at the school. This presentation will be by an Inuit woman named Goota. Goota offers presentations about the Inuit culture and the way of life of today and the past. She passionately shares her culture through storytelling and the use of authentic Inuit artifacts. Her interactive and hands-on teaching style makes learning a fun experience. The cost is \$10.00 per student and this fee will be added to your child's Power School account. The fee is based on all students participating; fees may be adjusted depending on the total number of students.

As a side note some traditional foods will be available for children to try if they like. Some of these are Traditional bubblegum, beluga whale, and some fish and some seal. This is optional. Please make a note if your child has any allergies specific to these foods.
