

# Strathcona County Museum - June 17th

Both Grade 4 classes will be participating in a field trip to the Strathcona County Museum located at 913 Ash St, Sherwood Park, for a tour and activities on **Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup>**. This field trip will complement our current Social Studies curriculum, as students will learn about Early Settlement in Alberta.

We will “examine pockets of history through various interactive tasks”. Students will “become history detectives and identify mystery artifacts”. They will explore the Museum with their “History Hunt”.

The bus will pick us up at school at 9:15 a.m., and we will return to school at 1:00. Upon returning to school, the Grade 4’s will have their lunch, and then regular afternoon classes will take place.

The cost for this field trip is **\$7.00 and can be paid on-line through your Parent Portal** on Powerschool. Please access the parent portal for your current balance as your account has to be up to date for your child to attend this field trip. We wouldn’t want anyone to miss this fun filled activity!
