

Telus World of Science Trip

Dear Parents,

As a culminating activity for our science unit Small, Crawling and Flying Animals and our Iqaluit unit in Social Studies, we will be visiting the Telus World of Science on **May 16th** for the day!

We'll be leaving the school at 8:45 AM. Upon arrival, we'll have an hour science presentation on Scales & Tails. After that we'll have an hour and fifteen minutes to explore the other exhibits including the environment gallery and have lunch before we head into the Zeidler Dome to watch a movie called Aurorae, which is all about the Northern Lights. After this show we will be headed to CuriousCITY, where the class will have time to explore and play. We will catch the bus back to the school by 2:15 in order to be back in time for dismissal.

The cost is \$24.18 per student (\$16.43 for the field trip and \$7.75 for the bus) and this fee will be added to your child's PowerSchool account. Please note that the fee is based on all students participating; fees may be adjusted depending on the total number of students.
