- 7:13pm Teacher's report presented by Angela P
  - **GENERAL** Participated in the Living Rosary walk outside in the school yard. Students responded well to the prayerful experience with their classroom teacher. Live Streamed Mass June 22 11:00
  - **Kindergarten** Thank you to families for supporting their child during the Google Meets and Google Slide activities as best you were able. We understand that at the kindergarten level online learning is the same as home learning because of the one-on-one adult help they require. Early Literacy: We continue with our sound friends -focusing on the vowel sounds; we review rhyming and listening for the beginning sound; we are using our white boards to 'sound out' and write some 3 letter words. Numeracy: During May we focused on 2D and 3D shapes, while always reviewing patterns, subitizing numbers to 10 and one more/one less. We are playing number BINGO to 20 (and we might try one game of Numbers to 100 on the very last day)! Thank you to Strathcona County and Active Schools for the various prizes that were donated. Religion: Students have been practicing the Our Father and Hail Mary prayers this month. Thank you to the CWL from OLPH parish for their past donation of a rosary for each child to take home. The Mon/Wed class was able to participate in the outdoor Rosary Walk and the Tues/Thurs class joined in the whole school for Funny/Messy Hair Day. Garden: Some of the tomatoes have survived, but not all of them (and that's the way it goes in gardening). We loved watching the Purple Peacock Pole Beans climb up to the ceiling and most who tried a taste liked earring them. We have picked, dried and saved some of these bean seeds for an experiment in Grade 1. Our outdoor garden is sprouting up with the pole beans, lettuce, swiss chard, potatoes, and flowers, so far.
  - **Grade 1** Bishop: Thank you to all of the families that facilitated online learning. I missed the class so much, and we're so excited to finish the school year together. · LA: We have started our Fairy Tales unit, and are currently on our second Fairy Tale, Goldy Luck and the Three Pandas, we will be moving on to Little Red and the Very Hungry Lion · Math: We recently completed our Addition and Subtraction to 20, and completed our Geometry

unit during online learning. We have just started our Measurement unit. · Social: We are studying and identifying the groups and communities we belong to. · Science: Grade 1 is continuing to work on our Plants and Animals unit, we will also visit our Grade 1 tree to discuss "Summer" in the next week.

- **Religion** We are creating a display in the classroom called Mary, Our Heavenly Mother. We see Mary as our model. She was fully a mother to Jesus. She loved and cared for Him just as your mother loves and cares for you. Students have been busy collecting images of their mother, as well as creating images of Mary.
- **Grade 1 / 2** Forslund: I was so proud of the hard work and dedication all my students and their families did during online learning. It was heartwarming to see. -We have also been doing a fairytale unit in LA and doing a variety of writing with this. The students all love this and have great creativity. -We finished measurement and are continuing with addition and subtraction. -Science is so much fun with the integration of the needs of plants and animals with small crawling and flying animals. We also learned the bumble bee song. This was from when I was little and they greatly adore it. -In social we will be starting to learn about Saskatoon and what this community is about. -Religion has us talking about the love our Mothers have for us. Talking about the love Mary has for Jesus and how we can look up to her in times of need.
- Grade 2 Hunt: Grade 2's did a great job with online learning! Thank you to all the parents for all their support through the process. · LA: We have explored a variety of fairy tales and students are now in the process of writing their own fractured fairy tale. · Math: Completed measurement and now moving onto graphing and interpreting data. · Social: We are learning about the Acadian community of Meteghan. · Science: We are learning about small crawling and flying animals and have started looking at food chains. · Religion: We have been learning all about Mother Mary and how Jesus will always be with us.
- Grade 3 Gauthier: Students in grade 3 did an amazing job during our online learning. They completed their assignments so well and were so attentive while online. Thank you to all those parents who supported their child through our online learning. · LA - The students just finished a Magic Tree House novel called Dolphins at Daybreak. · Math - Students are working on our Measurement and Time unit. · Science - Our students released their butterflies and are learning about different animal life cycles. · Social - We are studying the country of India. · Religion - The students enjoyed learning about Mary and participated in the Living Rosary.
- Grade 3 / 4 Podoborozny: Student's in grade 3/4P did a great job during online learning. The students completed meaningful tasks and a big thank you to parents for helping support their child through this transition. · LA: Students are working on Opinion writing. They are learning how to support their ideas with evidence from the text. · Math: Grade 3 & 4 students are finishing their measurement and time unit. They will be moving onto geometry! · Science: Grade 3 students just released their butterflies after learning about the life cycle. Grade 4 students are continuing their wheels and levers unit. They will be conducting experiments to demonstrate their understanding of simple machines. · Social: Grade 3 students are studying the country of Peru. They are learning about the culture and lifestyle of a student in grade 3. Grade 4 students are learning about early

explorers. · Religion: The students enjoyed the month of Mary and being able to participate in the living rosary.

 Grade 4 Prenoslo: Students did a wonderful job of being engaged with Online Learning. Grade fours were well equipped to do most activities independently. A big thank you to parents for your support. · LA: We finished our novel study of Owls in the Family and the students were very interested in the many owl facts we learned along the way. · MATH: Completed fractions, decimals, and money unit. Completed with a shopping trip to the 4P Store:) · SOCIAL: We are learning about early explorers · SCIENCE: Finishing our Wheels and Levers with 2 construction activities and fair testing. · Religion: enjoyed leading the Mary school assemblies for the month of May.
