Welcome to our 2021/22 school year!



My name is Tracey Pineau and I feel very blessed and honoured to be able to be a part of your child's education journey this year. I have been an elementary teacher for over ten years and my last four years have been in the Brighter Beginnings/New Pathways program at both Madonna school and at SaintJohn XXIII. It was during this time that I received most of my experience with children with complex needs. I find teaching in a classroom with children with complex needs extremely rewarding and I am so excited to finally meet your little ones face to face!

During the next few weeks of September, our wonderful PUF Pathways team will be able to get to know your child's interests and abilities in order to design a program that will be specially tailored to their strengths and needs. The Pathways team members that are in the classroom on a daily basis include myself and our lovely EA's Ms. Visagie and Mrs. McCloy.

Our Daily Routine

Our PUF Pathways hours are from 12:30 to 3:30. Although our days will be flexible to some extent, there will always be the element of a predictable routine.

Our typical day will consist of:

- Arrival activities (play dough, puzzles, building blocks, etc.)
- Circle time (movement exercises and stories)
- Exploratory play (i.e sensory materials, science exploration, art, imagination games, fine and gross motor activities, etc.).
- Snack break
- Calendar time (Movement, Literacy and Numeracy focus)

We will also occasionally have an Occupational Therapist and a Speech and Language Pathologist in our classroom, so your child will have many enriched learning opportunities!

Please note: Once our students are comfortable with our classroom routines, I will try to spend at <u>least part of our day outside</u> (weather permitting) so please be mindful to dress your child for the appropriate temperature (or put the extra clothing in the backpack). As well, on any given day we might get messy with various art mediums, and although we have art smocks that are offered, your child may not always successfully wear one. Please dress your child for having fun!

We have a family photo board that is displayed for our students to see before they enter the classroom. Please send us a photo of your family so that we may put it up for our display!




Birthdays
