NEW Alberta Health Daily Checklist

The Alberta Daily Screening tool has recently changed. A new question about household contacts has been added for both over 18 and under 18.

Has your child been a household contact of a case2 of COVID-19 in the last 14 days? A household contact: a person who lives in the same residence as the case OR who has been infrequent, long-duration, close-range interaction with a case of COVID-19. For example, siblings, someone who slept over, or someone who provided direct physical care to the child.

If the answer is "YES" AND they are NOT fully immunized: Child should stay home and NOT attend school, childcare and/or other activities for 14 days from the last day of exposure and monitor for symptoms. If your child has symptoms, proceed to question 2.
