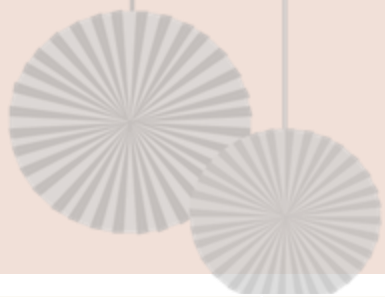

OUR LEARNING

Traditionally a very long-feeling month, this January seemed to fly by! We had an amazing month filled with a lot of learning and celebration! This month, we continue our social-emotional learning with Valentine's Day and ongoing visits from Hannah, a Mental Health Capacity Builder from AHS/FRN.

We are continuing in our journey into reading and writing words by exploring vowel sounds and letters using the Animated Literacy program, allowing us to more effectively build and decode words. We are continuing to explore different texts and even reading simple words and sentences.

In numeracy, we are continuing to explore 10s-how to build up to and represent groups of 10 (this is important in learning to add, subtract, and build bigger numbers), as well as looking at shapes, patterns, and time.

In religion, February is an important month-not only are we talking about love with Valentine's Day, but we can also talk about God's love for us. In addition, we are focusing on the beginning of Lent and the different ways that we can be repentant.

SPECIAL EVENTS

We are so excited to have the opportunity for many special celebrations this month, including African dance, Les Boucheronnes, Shrove Tuesday, Ash Wednesday, etc.! Students from both classes are welcome to attend these events with a parent, and families are also welcome to join us at Mass. Sending peers Valentine's Day cards is a great way to practice printing and identifying letters, and to talk about letter sounds. This is not mandatory, but we do ask that if your child is bringing Valentines, they bring for the whole class. Students are also welcome to bring in a small box to build and decorate "mailboxes."
