The goal of this program is to spark the imagination of children and to help them enhance their literacy skills.

A few important notes:

- ★ Students are visiting a farm, they should <u>not</u> wear uniforms.
- ★ We will be inside a barn all morning, so please ensure your child has closed toed shoes (<u>no sandals/flip flops</u>) and long pants (<u>no shorts or skirts</u>).
- ★ We will be eating lunch at the farm after the program, students must bring a lunch suitable for a picnic. Spoons and napkins will <u>not</u> be provided. Bring a water bottle.
- ★ The bus will leave the school at 9:15 and return at 1:15. Do not be late for school that day.
- ★ The cost of the program is \$10.50 and is posted on your Parent Portal in PowerSchool. <u>Please ensure</u> payment is made by June 7th.
- ★ Please email Mrs. Bourassa if your child has any allergies to animals, animal hair, dust, hay or environmental allergies.
