On December 5th, 2024 we have an in school presentation by Strathcona Wilderness Center. Students will learn about how birds and animals survive when the season is cold and covered with snow! The Nature Detective will visit our classroom and by using hands-on displays and activities to allow students to discover the wonder of winter survival in Alberta. During the outside activities the students will stretch their imaginations and learn what they need to do to survive during our cold winter months. This correlates with the Kindergarten program of studies as we explore how environments change overtime.

The cost for this program is \$10.28 per student.
