Dear Parents,

On Tuesday June 10th, we have the opportunity to participate in a field trip to Safety City to take part in their ***Pedestrian Traffic Safety Program*** program. This program focuses on learning traffic safety through role play. When your students arrive they will participate in a 30-minute interactive presentation where they will learn how to cross the street safely using the “7 Steps of Safety” and basic traffic rules like traffic lights and signs. They will then transition to our outside portion where they will practice what they have learned by being both pedestrians and drivers in our Safety City. This program connects to the social curriculum (examining places in communities, work and play in harmony with others to create a safe and caring environment, examining how people in a community cooperate, learning how to move around our community safely) and physical education and wellness curricula (exploring outdoor environments, moving safely through different environments, moving their bodies safely in different spaces by themselves and with others).

****Every student must bring a properly fitted bike helmet in order to participate in the program.****

The cost for this program is \$12.80

\$9.28 program fee

\$3.51 bus fee

Please note that this amount is based on full class participation. The “per student” cost may and will change depending on the number of students attending and there will be no refunds. Payment is required before the event in order for your child to participate. There is no field trip form required as this trip is covered under the low-risk consent in PowerSchool.
