Field Trip Fees and How I Pay Them?




Fees:

- 2. Attend the Open House on March 16th, 2016 from 6:30 to 7:30 with your Kindergarten student.
- 3. Sign-up for an Orientation Session on-line at www.schoolinterviews.ca Event Code: 4xq87
- 4. Purchase school supplies.
- 5. Participate in the First Ride Program with your child if they will take the bus next year.

Orientation Sessions

To start off on the right foot, we introduce our Kindergarteners to school in small groups, offering them an opportunity to view their school and classroom prior to the first day.

- Students receive special, personal one-on-one time with their teacher to help them feel comfortable.
- Students will be shown where to put their belongings such as coat/shoes/backpacks.
- A tour of their class, washrooms, library, gym and office will take place.
- A photo of each student will be taken for their name tag.
- Students will be invited to participate in a few activities.
